5 years most important contributions	a) During the past 5 years I have been conducting research in the area of <i>Aging and Communication Technologies</i> and developed this domain not only in Romania, through data collection, publications, early career researchers involvement and mentorship, but also at the European level, by being a prominent voice in the discussions about the use and mis(use) of the communication technologies later in life. By bridging theory, methodological innovation, policy creation and participatory approach, while doing research with older adults in trans-national contexts, I believe I set some standards on doing research by taking the perspective of community members and the

academia in close relationship. In this context, *I consider myself a candidate for Mattei Dogan award – as he has set the comparative method as a way to explain social phenomena and be in touch with the social reality.*

I will briefly describe the most important contribution in the field of social sciences, starting with 2019 until the present:

1. In 2019 I became the president (chair) of European Network of Aging Studies (ENAS), after being a board member before (see <https://temp.agingstudies.eu/organization/>). I was the first Eastern European board member and president of ENAS elected by the community of the researchers who are part of this organization and who are actively involved in conducting research in the aging domain from the social perspective.

2. While being the president of ENAS (2019-2021), I organized ENAS & NANAS joint conference in Bucharest (28 September – 1st October, 2022). It was a joint event of the European Association of Aging Studies and the North American Association of Aging Studies – the two most important forums of debate on ageing studies in the field of the social sciences. The event brought together the most important theoretical voices worldwide and generated multiple methodological debates (<https://enas.comunicare.ro/contact/>)

3. The concept of “visual ageism”, launched in the literature by myself and the Dutch Researcher, Eugene Loos, is nowadays widely quoted in the literature (190 citations) and it is used by the World Health Organization – that recognized our contribution is studying the ageism in the media (see <https://www.uoc.edu/divulgacio/comein/recursos/documents/l-ivan-edatisme-visual-practiques-socials-i-representacio-de-les-persones-grans-als-mitjans-de-comunicacio-EN.pdf>)

4. The concept of “technology generations” – launched by myself & Eugene Loos managed to get attention in one of the most prestigious journals in the area of Media Studies – *New Media & Society* (Impact factor=6.9).

Older Adults Co-Creating a Sustainable Age-friendly City (ENUTC EU grants) <https://cityco.snsra.ro/> (2022-2024) – total 990.000 euro, financed by Horizon 2020 (COFUND Contract no: 298/ 2022). The total budget for Romania is 250.000 euro. The project aims to create and adapt an instrument to assess the age-friendliness of different cities from the perspective of older adults, using a participatory
